Globalists Gather in Davos: Vow to Crush Russia, Putin

In between sessions dedicated to combating “climate change,” ensuring “environmental sustainability,” promoting “diversity” and “inclusion,” and preparing for the next pandemic, the global power elite attending the World Economic Forum’s Davos 2022 (WEF) meeting in Switzerland in late May were united on maintaining the American-centric unipolar world order established in the aftermath of WWII. And, scarily, they seem intent and united on crushing any nation challenging that order.

That was the main takeaway on the international relations front.

Sen. Joe Manchin (D-W.V.), one of many American attendees, insisted that he’s committed to crushing Russia and wants to see Ukraine “end with a win,” rather than a negotiated settlement to the devastating war with Russia, which includes “moving Putin back to Russia” and getting rid of him.

Similarly reckless comments have been made in recent weeks by U.S. politicians and pundits, demonstrating the hostility the power elite have toward Russia, which they hypocritically accuse of breaking the “rules-based order” that apparently does not apply to D.C. and its allies.

But it wasn’t just U.S. representa-

tives doubling down on their anti-Russian rhetoric and attitudes. European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen gave a speech where she described “Russia’s aggression” as a “task for the entire global community” to respond to.

“Ukraine must win this war,” von der Leyen emphatically stated. “And Putin’s aggression must be a strategic failure. We will do everything we can to help Ukrainians prevail and retake the future into their hands.”

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky, a darling of the Western press and political class, addressed the WEF meeting in a keynote televised address where he once again called for more economic sanctions and boycotts against Russia, including a

full oil embargo, cutting Russian banks off entirely from the global financial system, and a complete ban on trade with Russia.

George Soros got in on the anti-Russian action, saying the Russian invasion may have initiated WWII “and our civilization may not survive it.” He went on to describe the emerging conflict as one between “open” societies, such as the United States and the European Union, and “closed” societies, like Russia and China.

“Today, China and Russia present the greatest threat to open society,” Soros explained. “The best and perhaps only way to preserve our civilization is to defeat Putin.”

Joe Biden didn’t help matters when he dangerously insisted that the United States was prepared to militarily defend Taiwan against China, despite the longstanding “One China” policy that insists there is only one Chinese government based in Beijing.

“That’s the commitment we made,” Biden told reporters at a press conference in Tokyo with Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida, after responding that the U.S. would come to Taiwan’s aid militarily if it was attacked by mainland China.

The burgeoning Russia-China alliance, representing two emerging global powers that are increasingly tired of abiding by the dictates of Washington while being hypocritically lectured about a “rules-based order” and constantly threatened and provoked, is clearly a major challenge to the modern-day unipolar America-led world order. The elites who met in Davos—most of whom have never set foot on a battlefield—appear ready to do anything to ensure the elimination of any opposition, even if it means a world-ending nuclear war. ★
