CHANGE COMING

• Americans reject legacy media, left-wing agenda, phony politicians

We're halfway through 2022, and things are not looking good for the United States. The nation hasn't seen inflation this high since the 1970s. In the past two years, Covid-19 lockdowns have forced 100,000 small businesses across the country to close for good. Skyrocketing prices have largely put housing out of reach for most working-class Americans. Perhaps worst of all, as the war in Ukraine drags on, the threat of a nuclear exchange between Russia and the United States grows.

Yet despite this terrible news, there's still much to be hopeful for. The signs are everywhere that everyday Americans are finally waking up to the reality that their elected officials are not on their side and have failed them completely—or, worse, are actively pursuing policies and agendas against the interests of the people.

For example, Democrats are reportedly panicking over new reports that President Joe Biden's approval rating is now lower than former President Donald Trump's was in 2021 just after the Jan. 6 protests



when the mainstream media was hammering him over the raucous events. Biden's numbers are especially bad among young people and minorities, both of whom see the president for what he is: weak, addle-brained, and incompetent.

According to the latest polls, black and Hispanic Americans have been switching sides in record numbers to support conservative candidates, who advocate for individual rights and smaller government. A good example of this is newly elected Republican Rep. Mayra Flores of Texas, but there are others including South Carolina's Tim Scott and Georgia's Herschel Walker, as well as lesser-known names such

as Texas state Rep. Ryan Guillen, who, in 2021, switched his party affiliation to Republican in a major blow to southern Democrats.

It is not just elites in government who are being targeted. Americans are increasingly turning away from Big Media, the traditional propagandists for the ruling elites. Earlier in July, multiple reports surfaced that, despite new leadership,

CNN employees are "freaking out" over their cratering viewership. More and more Americans are turning off the Big Media, opting instead for independent media outlets and journalists that are not apologists for the elites and are not afraid to honestly tackle topics that the mainstream would never touch, such as rampant corruption and the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

These are just a few of the signs that signal average citizens today are plain fed up with the ruling establishment, specifically the Biden administration and their lackeys in the mainstream media.

Democrats concede that they expect a bloodbath in the 2022 mid-term elections, possibly even giving the next president, should he be a Republican, a supermajority in Congress in 2024.

The signs undoubtedly suggest positive changes are on their way, especially at the state level where conservative control of the executive, legislative, and judicial branches has risen dramatically in the past decade. ★
