## • Democrats seek radical restructuring if they win in November

f Sen. Chuck Schumer (D-Calif.) is to be believed, should Democrats gain control of the White House, the Senate and the House of Representatives next year, they will seek to enact a radical agenda to restructure the country as we know it.

Starting with how Americans vote, Schumer announced at the Democratic National Convention on Aug. 22, "This is not just another extraneous issue. This is the wellspring of it all."

Schumer was referring to legislation that Democrats have already introduced into Congress that would radically reshape the way Americans vote, undermining the integrity of future U.S. elections.

What Democrats refer to as "voting rights" refers to measures that would, for instance, make elections less secure by making it easier for non-citizens to vote in national elections, thereby ensuring Democrat victories for years to come.

Conservative news and commentary website "The Federalist" referred to one piece of Democrat-backed legislation—known formally as "the John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act (H.R. 14)—as "a power grab meant to circumvent the Supreme Court's 2013 decision that restrained the federal government's overreach into elections."

In other words, the Democrats want to throw out the Constitution and centralize election law so they can better control it.

Conservative writer Jonathan Tobin noted the bill would allow the Department of Justice to "intervene anywhere in the country to overrule local or state authorities whenever the left alleges that changes in the laws could theoretically disadvantage minority voters."

The bill would also empower a Democrat-controlled Department of Justice to wage war against states that enact voter ID legislation. Laws that require citizens to show ID when they vote are one of the best ways to ensure election integrity.

Last April, conservative billionaire Elon Musk brought attention to a plan by the Biden administration to flood Democrat-controlled states with millions of illegal aliens. Since the Census now counts illegal aliens, this will increase those state's representation in Washington. It's a recipe for one-party rule, warned Musk.

Making matters worse, in key Democrat-controlled areas, laws surrounding automatic voter registration have been watered down to make it simple for non-citizens to register to vote. Ballots are then mailed out, making vote fraud difficult to trace.

Former President and current Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump has long pressed for stricter voting laws and rightly claims that the use of early and mail-in voting can facilitate fraud.

Democrats have repeatedly tried to pass measures that centralize election law under their authority in Washington but have been repeatedly stymied by the Republican-led House.

Should the Democrats take control of the Senate and the House, it will be all but impossible for the GOP to block these radical moves.

And that's not all. Democrats are also planning a rash of Marxist-socialist policies that would undercut the free market in the United States. This includes imposing price controls on everything from groceries to medications. They are also seeking to upend the conservative Supreme Court by forcing term limits on it—or pack it with liberal justices.

Finally, despite the unprecedented national debt—which today stands at an eyepopping \$35 trillion—the Democrats want to hand out \$25,000 to first-time homebuyers as a bribe to get them to come out and vote Democrat.

On the campaign trail, Trump has repeatedly blasted the Democrats for trying to steal the election and enact their Marxist agenda.

The Democrats "are going to cheat like Hell to win the election because they have no bounds," Trump told a large gathering in Asheboro, N.C. on Aug. 21. "Our primary focus is not to get out the vote, it is to make sure they don't cheat."


