ELITES MEET IN DAVOS

• Public waking up to danger of globalism, self-appointed masters

As AFP goes to press, the annual meeting of the infamous World Economic Forum (WEF)—which boldly predicted that, by 2030, “you will own nothing and be happy”—wrapped up in Davos, Switzerland. The globalist confab, held under the auspices of building “cooperation in a fragmented world,” featured, as usual, some of the leading political, financial, academic, corporate, and media personalities from around the world. To open the four-day meeting, held between Jan. 16-20, Klaus Schwab—the villainous James Bond-type character straight out of central casting—called for those in attendance to work together to “master the future.”

“We couldn’t meet at a more challenging time,” Schwab, the founder and chairman of the WEF, stated in his opening remarks. “We are confronted with so many crises simultaneously.”

He argued that, in order to “master the future,” there needs to be “a platform where all stakeholders of global society are engaged—governments, business, civil society, the young generation.”

The problem with the elites who gathered in Davos—many flying thousands of miles on private jets as they

lecture average working- and middle-class people to make sacrifices in order to fight “climate change”—is their total disconnect from reality. The brazen hypocrisy, arrogance, and malevolence on display was simply astounding.

The only “stakeholders of global society” in attendance at the WEF’s annual meeting were the rich, well-connected elite globalists and their fellow travelers, who represent the interests of the wealthy plutocrats largely controlling the world. Where are the voices and representatives of the average hard-working citizens

across the planet who are struggling with rising inflation, stagnant wages, skyrocketing energy costs, massive displacements of peoples, rising crime rates, and unaffordable housing?

One day prior to the opening of the annual WEF meeting, OxFam, an international organization dedicated to fighting inequality and poverty, released a report titled “Survival of the Richest,” which documented how the “very richest have become dramatically richer and corporate profits have hit record highs, driving an explosion of inequality,” especially following the Covid-19 pandemic, in which the WEF played a key role in coordinating the global response.

While the world’s wealthiest and most powerful people gathered in Davos, where 5,000 Swiss military personnel were deployed to guard attendees, the rest of humanity continued to struggle to make ends meet, watching in real time as the rich get richer and the poor get poorer.

A key theme of the WEF conference, aside from the usual topics of “climate change,” pandemic preparedness, and environmental sustainability, was “mis- and disinformation,” which speakers, including Brian Stelter, a disgraced former CNN correspondent and leading promoter of disinformation, claims continue to erode trust in institutions, media outlets, and governments.

Given the role globalist organizations like the WEF and their mouthpieces and sycophants in the mass media, academia, and governments around the world have played in creating the dystopia and economic nightmare experienced by the vast majority of humanity, it is no wonder faith and trust in these institutions have so rapidly eroded. ★


